New Zealand Women's National Team 2019



Floorball New Zealand will enter a team into the Women's World Floorball Championship Qualification 2019. The competition will most likely take place in either Thailand, China or Philippines around the 30th January and the 3rd of February 2019. Confirmation of location and time is expected in the next couple of weeks.

It is possible there will be up to 6 teams participating at this event, which means that potentially 3 teams will qualify for the Women's World Floorball Championship Finals held in Switzerland in December 2019. The final details will be determined by IFF in the next couple of weeks.

1. Eligibility to play for NZ Women's National Team

To play for the New Zealand Women's team, a player needs to fulfil the following criteria:

- Be a licensed floorball player in New Zealand or in another IFF recognised national floorball association.
- Be a NZ citizen
- Be born on or before 1st December 2004

2. Selection of players and selection criteria

The size of the team is envisaged to be between 14 and 20 players.

Identification of eligible players will commence in the next couple of months, with the intention of starting the team selection beginning on the 20 August 2018. It is envisaged that the final team will be announced after the Wellington Open in September.

Team training weekends and other tournaments/events will serve as trials, please refer to point 3 for information about dates for those.

Floorball New Zealand has appointed Sven Sundin as the head coach for the Women's National team.

Sven will be selecting the team based on the following criteria:

- Floorball skills (dribbling, passing, shooting, positioning, tactical knowledge and understanding of the game)
- Fitness
- Attending regular club trainings either with a women's squad or with an adult team
- Attendance at potential training camps or team trainings
- Attitude, value and experience provided to team
- Team fit

After a player is selected for the team, a deposit is due to be paid to Floorball New Zealand to confirm the selection, refer point 4 for more information.



3.Training leading up to the qualifying tournament

All selected players are required to attend regular training with their respective clubs. The National team coach will be in contact with club coaches to follow individual progress of players. There will be a small cost associated with attending the training weekends.

In addition, the following training weekends and events are currently planned:

4. Costs and equipment for qualifying tournament

Each player needs to provide her own playing equipment. This includes goalies who are expected to have a full set of goalie gear.

Due to the small amount of funding and sponsorship currently available to Floorball New Zealand, it there will be a participation fee for players to cover costs for team fee, uniforms and team training. This is estimated to be between \$300 and \$400 and will be confirmed as soon as possible.

The team will stay together at the preparation training camp in Singapore and during the tournament. Each player will cover any airfares and accommodation costs in association with travelling to and from Singapore/Event Location.



Floorball New Zealand will endeavour to keep costs as low as possible and will also attempt to do some fundraising towards these costs.

After the selection of the players, each player is required to put down a deposit of \$300 paid into the Floorball NZ account in order to confirm the selection. This amount is used towards the team costs as stated above. Payment of this is due within 3 weeks after the player has been selected.

Players not making a deposit in the required time frame will not be confirmed as being selected.

5. What happens after the qualifying tournament

Depending on how many teams register to play in the qualification round, the top team(s) will qualify for the Women's World Floorball Championship Finals in 2019 which are held in Switzerland in December 2019. Should the New Zealand team qualify, then a team selection for that event will start after June 2019. Experience gained during the qualifying tournament will be an important selection criterion and it is anticipated that a large number of players from the qualifying tournament will also be available for a potential team for the Women's WFC in 2019.
